



MISSOURI VOTERS GUIDE FOR 2010 ELECTIONS



Voter Registration Deadline:

November 2nd General Election-application must be postmarked by October 6th

You will need to register to vote if you:

- Are a new voter
- Are a new resident to the State of Missouri
- have moved or changed your name since you last voted

Print it out and mail it to your local election authority

Absentee Voting:

For November Election-Absentee balloting will begin on *September 21, 2010*. Ballots can be filed in person at your local election authority or by mail. Ballots must be received by the end of the day on election day.

Absentee ballot applications must be mailed in or hand delivered-they cannot be emailed back or filled out online.
